For the reasons stated in the foregoing Memorandum Opinion, it is this 6th day of August 2010, ORDERED that:

1. Defendants Maryland Jockey Club of Baltimore City, Inc., Laurel Racing Association, LP, Thomas Chuckas, Jr. and Dennis Smoter's Partial Motion to Dismiss (Paper No. 109) is DENIED;
2. Defendants Maryland Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association, Maryland Horse Breeders Association, Inc., Richard J. Hoffberger and Alan Foreman's Motion to Dismiss (Paper No. 110) is:
  - a. GRANTED as to Count IV; and
  - b. DENIED as to Counts I, II, III, VI and VII;
